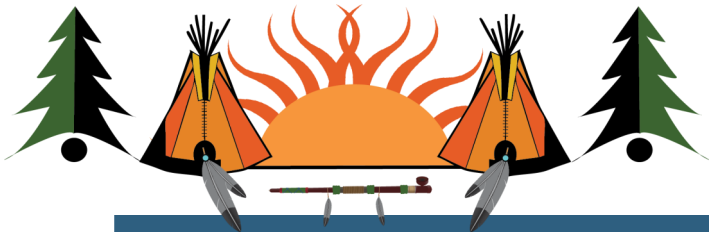
Ne-Chee Friendship Centre
