The Life Long Care Program:

The Lifelong Care Program provides services and care for people of all ages that have physical disabilities, serious health issues, or those who are frail and or/elderly. The goal of the program is to assist program participants in stabilizing their health.

Assistance with the coordination of medical appointments, transportation, prevention of isolation through interaction and social activities, referrals and advocacy to access community supports. Services can be provided on a short-term basis and will be determined through an intake and assessment process



Program Services include:

- Security Checks (in person or over the phone)
- Home visits/Friendly Visits
- Congregate Dining (Meal and Activity)
- Diabetes Support Programming
- Healthy Living Programming
- Medical Transportation Services & Escorts
- Referrals to Community services & Friendship Centre Programs
- Support with applications/forms and Internet issues.
- Client Advocacy
- Housing Assistance
- Support Transitioning from ODSP to Old Age Pension
- Locating a family doctor or other health care provider.
- Assistance sourcing medical equipment & supplies
- Caregiver Support Referrals
